FAQs

What internships are available?

You can choose experiences in urban or suburban communities in anglo or ethnic contexts. Specialized experiences in non-profit management, administrative support, media, communication, graphic-design and technology can be arranged.

What can I expect to experience?

You'll be embedded in a new church for a hands-on learning experience. You'll be stretched and strengthened as both a ministry servant and leader. You will also be given study assignments to further your biblical education.

What's required of me?

- Enrollment in college or a recent graduate.
- 25 hrs/week of service and leadership plus additional study time.
- Personal support raising. This is a foundational skill for church planting and an important part of your internship. Typical internships require \$600/week. Some may require additional funds.
(Donors will receive a tax deductible receipt from the CEA.)

Will I be paid as an intern?

Yes. Typically, interns receive \$500/week for room & board and personal expenses plus reimbursement for approved business expenses, including mileage if a personal vehicle is required. However, you will be responsible for travel to and from the internship location (those expenses are not reimbursable.) Your supervisor will assist you in setting a budget

How do I get started?

2. Select a location and plan your support budget together with your CEA Internship Supervisor.
